## We Welcome the Joy, Laughter, Sights, and Sounds of Children in Worship!

There are children's activity bulletins and worship activity bags available - just ask our ushers. If a moment out of the sanctuary is needed, a toy-filled nursery and changing table are available too, however, we ask that an adult family member stay present at all times.

#### Set Apart to Serve

In our reading from Acts, we hear about a group of people who were set apart to serve in a different way than the apostles. We still have church leaders who are called in different ways today. The ELCA ordains two kinds of leaders in the Church: Ministers of Word and Sacrament (pastors), and Ministers of Word and Service (deacons). Both are called to preach the Word of God and lead the people of God in public ministry. For pastors, the most visible way this happens is in worship, especially in the administration of the sacraments (communion and baptism). Deacons, on the other hand, are often called to specialized ministries, such as youth leadership, hospital chaplaincy, prison ministry, social work, or other faith-based work. The work of pastors and deacons sometimes overlaps, but they are called in different ways. It isn't just rostered leaders who do the work of ministry; pastors, deacons, lay staff, and volunteers do this Gospel work in our communities. The Spirit works through us all in different ways, and we all have gifts we can use for the Kin-dom of God!
